Mike reported there was an unusually long Membership Meeting due to the individual awards that were presented and the high number of judging recognition awards. Tadge Juechter, recently retired as Executive Chief Engineer and Josh Holder, the current Chief Engineer, along with Ray Theriault, the Corvette Assembly Plant Director, joined the distinguished Engineer panel on Wednesday afternoon. It was the best ever attended and a lively discussion amongst them all. Fortunately for the attendees, Josh did drive a prototype ZR-1 to the Convention for the looky-loos to drool over and see what to expect. The displays on the Show Floor included twelve American Heritage Award-winning Corvettes, fabulous cars!

Sharyl suggested that NCC make donations to Meals on Wheels in Contra Costa, Solano, and Yolo Counties, and to the Alameda Food Bank. The members approved \$200 donations to each. The checks will be hand delivered.

A donation to the NCRS Foundation was discussed but tabled till next month. Sharyl mentioned that two NCC's member's grandchildren have received scholarships from the Foundation.

Sharyl also suggested that NCC to reinstate the Chapter Top-Flight Award (CTFA) program for 2025. This was discussed and approved provided that a volunteer step up to head that program.

### Show and Tell/Slide Shows:

Sandy Houck showed pictures of repairing a big dent in her '67 oil pan. Spot welds were redone and are practically nondetectable.

Wayne Yurtin described the history of his '65 car and how he set it up for land speed racing. He showed pictures and a heart-stopping video of his "Blue Flame" at the El Mirage dry lakebed and Bonneville Speed Week. The El Mirage track record is 200 mph. Wayne recorded 198.2 mph in the modified GT class. At Bonneville he broke the 202 mph record with a 228 mph run! Kingston Wulff was there and commented there was a strong side wind. Stay tuned, Wayne plans on doing 250 mph next year.

It is obvious how much the members are energized when it comes to looking at pictures and having discussions about cars, so look through your repair, upgrading, or driving pics. Then tell Jeff to schedule your presentation.

Glorie McNay reported that 300 cars are leaving northern California as part of the National Road Tour to the National Corvette Museum 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary.

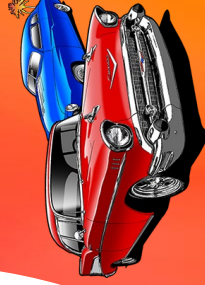
