It was the best ever attended and a lively discussion amongst them all. Fortunately for the attendees, Josh did drive a prototype ZR-1 to the Convention for the looky-loos to drool over and see what to expect. The displays on the Show Floor included twelve American Heritage Awardwinning Corvettes, fabulous cars!

Wayne recorded 198.2 mph in the modified GT class. At Bonneville he broke the 202 mph record with a 228 mph run! Kingston Wulff was there and commented there was a strong side wind. Stay tuned, Wayne plans on doing 250 mph next year.

It is obvious how much the members are energized when it comes to looking at pictures and having discussions about cars, so look through your repair, upgrading, or driving pics. Then tell Jeff to schedule your presentation.
