Membership Report:

Old Business:

April 11-12 Los Gatos Spring Meet: Sharyl will meet with the hotel manager. So far four cars are registered to be flight judged.

NCC Text Group: It is up and running.

Garage Visits: Discussed ideas on how to start the program and when to schedule.

Calendar: Discussed how to fill in local events without conflicting with National events.

New Business:

Chapter Top Flight Award (CTFA): Discussed re-starting the program after last years' time off.

National Convention: Sharyl will be soliciting Chapters to make \$300 donations for meals for judges and tabulators. The Board approved a \$300 donation.

Los Angeles Wildfires: The Board approved a \$1000 donation to the Red Cross of the Greater Los Angeles Area.

Membership Recruitment: Discussed requesting members to promote NCRS when attending car events.

Open Discussion:

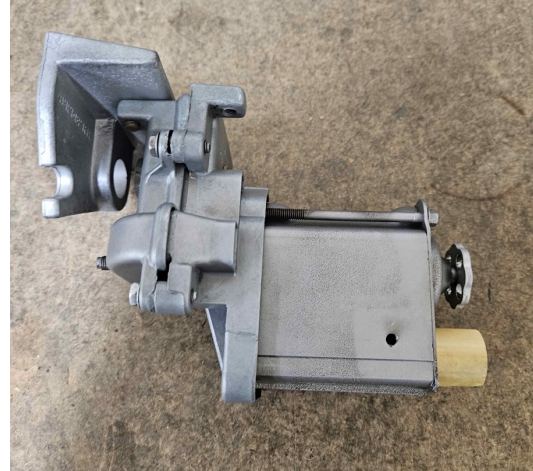
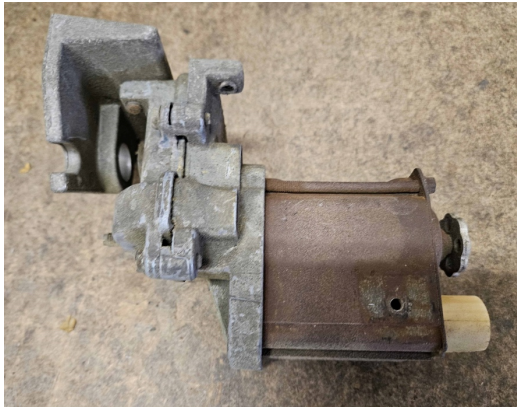

1956-57 Courtesy Light Door Jamb Switch

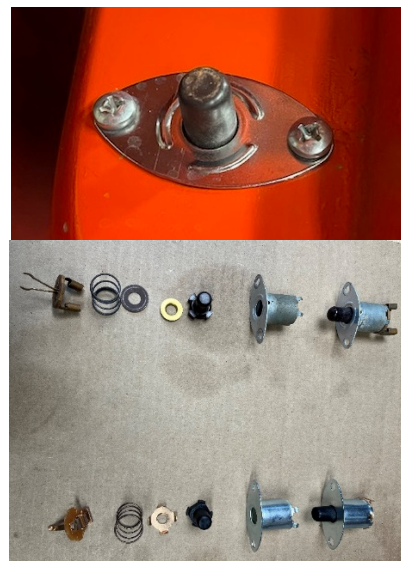
There are two items unique to a 1956-57 Corvette Courtesy Light Door Jamb Switch. They are the button color and the smooth surface that is visible. The button should be dark brown Bakelite. The unpolished stainless steel switch faceplate should be smooth with no stamped embossments. From the JM: "These switches are smooth faced, unpainted

and normally use brown plastic contact buttons." "The switch mounting flanges should be smooth and not contain any ridges."

Finding a replacement is a challenge to know what to look for. Buttons can be black or dark brown. The switch plate face on replacements has three stamped embossed curved areas around the button. This is also the typical configuration for 1958-62 Corvettes. Both items are possible to correct and will require disassembling the switch.

A switch with the typical dark brown button will be possible to find. The door jamb switch with the typical switch faceplate is found on 1941-56 Chevy trucks PN 4598597, and on 1955-56 passenger cars. Carefully look at the switch plate face when purchasing on-line. Some of those listed with the correct PN will have embossments. The issue with a switch installed in steel vehicles is the body is used as the ground. The switch has only one wire terminal on the back. Corvettes will have two terminals. The second terminal goes to ground.

If you obtain switches for a steel body car, you will also need the switches that were in the Corvette. The four switches will need to be disassembled so that the section with the two terminals from a Corvette can be installed into the stainless-steel body with a smooth faceplate. It is easy to bend the four prongs on the back to disassemble the switch. Then reverse the process to assemble it.

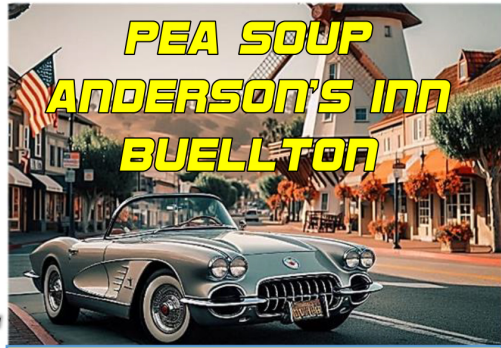
